Huna Totem Corporation is seeking applicants to fill two Interpretive Services positions: Onboard Host/Guide.

Successful applicants will board cruise ships entering Glacier Bay National Park. Onboard the cruise ships, successful applicants will provide a cultural interpretation program about Glacier Bay and the Huna people to the passengers.

Cultural interpretation includes explaining the Huna Tlingits' history and traditions as they relate to Glacier Bay, pointing out various areas of significance (past and present), telling stories, etc.

Candidates must be very dependable and possess the ability to focus on responsibilities; the ability to speak Tlingit is a plus.

In addition, candidates:

- Must be punctual – workdays may begin as early as 5:00 a.m.
- Must be physically fit – boarding the cruise ships is done by transfer from a smaller boat traveling at nine knots.
- Must be energetic – a typical workday will be twelve hours.
- Must be able to speak to large audiences – presentations may be given to groups of 300 +.
- Must be able to manage time – the workday will follow a set schedule.
- Must be a team player – will be working closely with Park Service Naturalists and ship crew members.
