Dear Shareholder,

As a Huna Totem shareholder, I want to provide you with early notice of Huna Totem Corporation's 2011 summer internship program which will include two paid internship positions this summer. As part of its mission to provide economic benefits to our current and future generations of shareholders, and to encourage and perpetuate the cultural values of our Native people, Huna Totem Corporation established a summer internship program last year. During the summer of 2010, we had the good fortune to have two students join us for paid internships.

Huna Totem Corporation Summer Internships are open to students currently enrolled at an institute of higher learning who have completed their freshman year. The positions will be primarily based in Juneau at Huna Totem Corporation's headquarters and will likely involve travel to and time in Hoonah working at Icy Strait Point.

Internship positions are full time and will involve assisting on a variety of projects in one or more of the following business lines and functional areas:

- *Icy Strait Point*, Alaska's only privately owned cruise ship port;
- *Cultural Interpretive Services* which provides cultural interpretation programs for cruise ship visitors to Glacier Bay National Park;
- *Finance & Accounting*;
- *Shareholder Services*;
- *Office of the CEO*;
- *Huna Heritage Foundation*, our non-profit affiliate working with historical archives; or
- *Denali Advisors*, quantitative-based, institutional investment management firm in which Huna Totem Corporation is a significant investor.

Depending on student interest, the program can be either:

- i) A broad based rotation allowing the intern to spend a block of time in each of the Corporation's major business lines & functional areas; or
- ii) A focused experience within the one or two business lines or functional areas most closely corresponding to the intern's coursework and career interests.

Additionally, I would like to ask for your help in spreading the word about our summer internship program and encouraging qualified Huna Totem Corporation shareholders, decedents, and Alaska Natives to apply.
